

2026 All Schools Wavepool Surftag

Dear Sports Coordinator,

The 2026 All Schools Wavepool Surftag is scheduled to be held at URBNSURF Sydney on Monday 25th to Thursday 28th May. Sessions will be available to book at 4.00pm, 6.00pm & 8.00pm each day.

The 2026 All Schools Wavepool Surftag will be the second event of the 2026 All Schools Surftag Series with 4 x Divisions being contested.

Ratings points will be on offer in Senior Boys, Junior Boys, Girls & Primary School Divisions with each team surfing a 1 x hour session at URBNSURF Sydney.

1. Senior Boys Division (Years 10, 11 & 12)
2. Girls Division (All Ages)
3. Junior Boys Division (Years 7, 8 & 9)
4. Primary Schools (Mixed, 6 years old and above)

Each team will be represented by 5 x surfers plus 1 x reserve or teacher/team manager/coach can surf in the 1 x hour session.

Each team will submit 10 x waves from 5 x surfers to be judged.

Each team's waves will be available to download on the Flowstate website

Senior Boys teams can include 2 x Junior surfers from the same High School.

Girl's teams can include 2 x Primary school surfers from the same School/Surf Academy.

Junior Boys teams can include 2 x Primary school surfers from the same School/Surf Academy.

Please return your entry form ASAP to confirm your Schools participation, all URBNSURF sessions need to be confirmed by Monday 11th May.

Format & Judging

1. Each team will surf in 1 x session (1 x hour) at URBNSURF Sydney – Advanced Turns or Customised Setting.
2. Each team will include 5 x surfers plus 1 x reserve or teacher/team manager/coach
3. 6 x Teams will surf in each 1 x hour session – 3 x teams per side of wavepool.
4. Each team will surf every third set in the 1 x hour session
5. Interference Penalty will be incurred if a surfer rides a wave in another teams set of waves (Penalty – Team Total less 1 x wave per Penalty)
6. Each team will surf both sides of the wavepool for approx. 30 minutes
7. Each team will be judged on their best 10 x waves from 5 x surfers to determine their overall score
8. Each team will have access to their waves via the Flowstate website for download – <https://flowstate.zone/en>
9. Each team will upload their best 10 x waves from 5 x surfers (can be either 10 x rights, 10 x lefts or a mix of each) to be judged.
10. Upload cut off - 10.00pm, Friday 5th June.

12. Results will be published on Instagram @surftagseries

*** The 6th surfer in each team gives you an option to surf another competitor in the session or have a team manager/coach in the water to give advice.

Count Backs

If two or more teams are tied the top 8 x waves from 4 x surfers will be calculated to determine the result. This process will be repeated if still tied using 6 x waves, 4 x waves and 2 x waves until a result is established.
